

**Supply List for Ms. Desjarlais  
(Explorers, Grades 3 and 4)**

**Supplies cannot be shared, so please label everything.**

**If you have supplies from last year, such as the recorder, and they are still in usable condition, please feel free to reuse them!**

- 1 inch 3-ring hard cover binder for in-class storage (any color or pattern)
- 1 3-hole punched folder to go inside the 3-ring binder (for homework papers)
- 1 pack of 3-hole punch lined notebook paper (to be kept at home)
- Pencils (for school and home)
- 5 packs of 3 X 5 index cards (keep three at home; you may need to replenish this supply during the year.)
- 6 pink/white bar erasers - Latex free; pencil-top erasers (optional)
- 3 glue sticks
- Ruler with 12 inches on one side and metric on the other
- 1 clipboard large enough for a 8.5 x 11 inch paper
- 1 pack of markers
- 1 set of colored pencils
- Pencil box or pencil case (you may need more than one of these for markers, pencils, and dry erase markers)
- Set of fine-tip dry erase markers (at least 4 colors) with eraser and cleaner
- Scissors
- 1 6-pack of sticky notes (any color)
- 1 pair of earbuds/headphones to be kept at school in a labeled container/bag
- Computer mouse with USB cord for using with school laptops (this will be kept at school; please, no wireless mice)
- A plastic soprano recorder for practice at home. These can be purchased at most local music stores or online for \$5 -\$7.
- A complete change of clothes (including socks and undergarments) in case of mud, puddles etc.
- 1 tub of Clorox/store brand wipes
- 1 box of tissues (this may need to be replenished during the year)

Note: The children do play in the snow during afternoon and recess and sometimes during PE classes. Please be sure your child has snow pants, boots & gloves/mittens on PE days and on any days there is snow outside.

**Art Supplies**

- 5 regular #2 pencils
- 1 latex free eraser
- 1 box of Crayola Classic Colors (10 bold color washable broad tip markers)
- 1 ruler
- 1 box of Crayola pre-sharpened colored pencils, 36 count

**Supplies to have at home:**

- Coloring tools such as markers, colored pencils, or crayons
- Ruler with 12 inches on one side and metric on the other
- Index cards
- Glue or glue sticks
- Working printer (this is a requirement in the middle school)
- Pencils
- Scissors

**Each student must have the following supplies on hand for the start of the school year.**

- Individual hand sanitizer (at least 60% alcohol);
- Face covering/mask\* (students in grade 2 and above REQUIRED; students in PK, K and 1 strongly suggested), including one spare to be kept at school;
- Individual container of disinfectant wipes;
- ~58 quart "Sterilite" or "Rubbermaid" style container with lid, labeled;

- Individual stadium seat, beach or camp chair for use in outdoor classrooms;
- Individual classroom and art supplies in individual, labeled cases;
- Individual box of tissues;
- Individual water bottle (fountains may not be shared at this time);
- Individually-packed cold lunches with all necessary plates and utensils;
- Individual computer mice, earphones, etc. as applicable. Earphone/earbuds, etc. are required for grades 2 – 8.
- Individual sunscreen and bug spray (or come to school with it already applied).

\*Note on face covering: Covering should fit securely over the nose and mouth, and stay on comfortably all day. Face shields are not recommended, and therefore not allowed without the use of a mask, as well.
